

PURPOSE

ASSESS THE DEPTH AND BREADTH OF THE VALUE OF PRIVATE, NONPROFIT HIGHER EDUCATION TO THE NATION, TOLD THROUGH NARRATIVE STORIES AND QUANTITATIVE ANALYSIS

FOCUS IS ON THE ECONOMIC, SOCIAL AND CULTURAL VITALITY THAT IS ADDED TO LOCAL COMMUNITIES, REGIONS AND THE NATION



SCOPE OF RESEARCH

DESIGN INCLUDED THREE GENERAL ELEMENTS

- FINANCIAL, STAFF, ENROLLMENT AND COMPLETION DATA FROM IPEDS FOR FY 2018 AND ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-19; ECONOMIC MODELS; AND PHILANTHROPY & VOLUNTEERISM MODELS
- INTERVIEWS WITH A VARIETY OF LEADERS FROM BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY, POLITICS, EDUCATION AND LOCAL COMMUNITIES
- A SURVEY OF INSTITUTIONS FOR EXAMPLES OF COMMUNITY INITIATIVES, PARTNERSHIPS AND OUTREACH EFFORTS

DATA AND INFORMATION COLLECTED AT THE NATIONAL LEVEL AND FOR EACH OF THE EIGHT REGIONS IN NAICU'S GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE




PRIOR TO THE PANDEMIC THE UNEMPLOYMENT GAP BETWEEN THOSE WITH A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR LESS AND THOSE WITH A BACHELOR'S DEGREE OR MORE WAS JUST 2.2%.

BY MAY 2020, THE GAP HAD GROWN TO 8.8%






